PUBLIC HEARINGS

8.a. <u>Public Hearing (Legislative) 1600 Reynolds Road Small Scale Comprehensive Plan Future Land Use Map Amendment (SSPA 2021-03)</u>

Mr. Stiell presented the above item. He stated it is a request for consideration of a small-scale comprehensive plan future land use map amendment to the Florida Department of Commerce to change the future land use designation from Commercial to Rural Residential on a 60.00-acre parcel.

Russell Large with Inovia appeared before the board and stated Mr. Stiell gave a great summary of what they are requesting.

Chair Bouie asked if anyone had any questions for the applicant and no one did.

Commissioner Sherman asked Mr. Stiell for clarification on the change of land.

Chair Bouie stated with not hearing any further concerns, they will look at the options they were provided.

Commissioner Stallworth asked if the applicant knew when they would have a finished product, and the applicant stated hopefully within 12 months.

Mr. Stiell stated he is not sure how things have been going but he would like to establish some ground rules on communication between himself and the board.

Mr. Stiell asked Attorney Baptiste if he had a chance to speak with the board on the senate bill 180, and Attorney Baptiste stated no he had not had the chance to speak with them.

Mr. Stiell stated that projects like this going forward will not come before the board, it will be a staff decision with staff review and sending it to the DRC.

Attorney Baptiste stated there is not an option for public input on the new bill.

Commissioner Jimenez stated she was concerned that the new bill didn't allow public input.

Commissioner Stallworth asked how a citizen would be able to voice their concerns.

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Commissioner Stallworth stated there was something in the works for the board to go to training and was wondering where they were with it. Mr. Stiell stated he would have to look into this.

Commissioner Moore asked if the December meeting date would be the 11th, and Mr. Stiell stated yes that is the date.
